A CORE MENTAL HEALTH DISCIPLINE

Marriage and Family Therapy is a core mental health discipline that views mental illness and family problems as best treated within a family context.

Marriage and Family Therapy is recognized by the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) as one of the five core mental health disciplines, along with psychiatry, psychology, social work and psychiatric nursing.

There are more than 50,000 Marriage and Family Therapists working in all 50 states, including the District of Columbia.

Marriage and Family Therapists evaluate and treat mental, emotional, behavioral and health problems as well as address a wide array of relationship issues within the context of the family system. Using a variety of theoretical approaches, Marriage and Family Therapists effectively treat individuals, couples, families and groups.
